Our local businesses and services are scaling down operation to serve our essential needs, in order to protect the personal health and safety of the citizens of our small community. We rely on our small businesses to support our residents, and they do not have the resources to support high volumes of visitors at this difficult time.

Like many other small communities, Bowen Island has extremely limited resources to serve our citizens. As the window narrows to help "flatten the curve" we need everyone's help – including the thousands of visitors who love and cherish our beautiful island.

"This has been a difficult decision for tourism, which plays such an important role in our local economy," said Murray Atherton of Tourism Bowen Island, "We hope that you will enjoy Bowen Island through images and your memories of past visits, and we are looking forward to welcoming everyone back in the future."
